

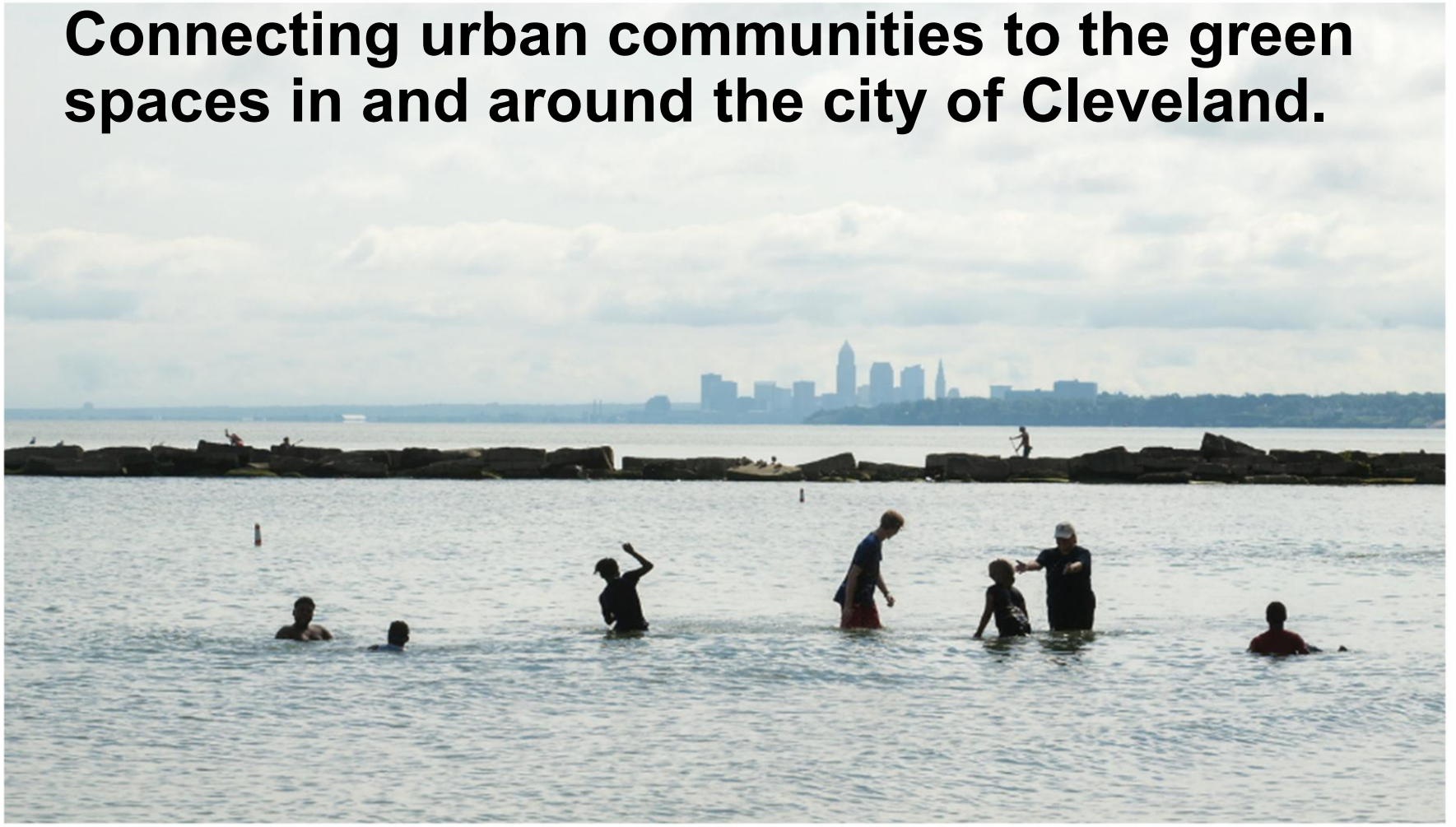

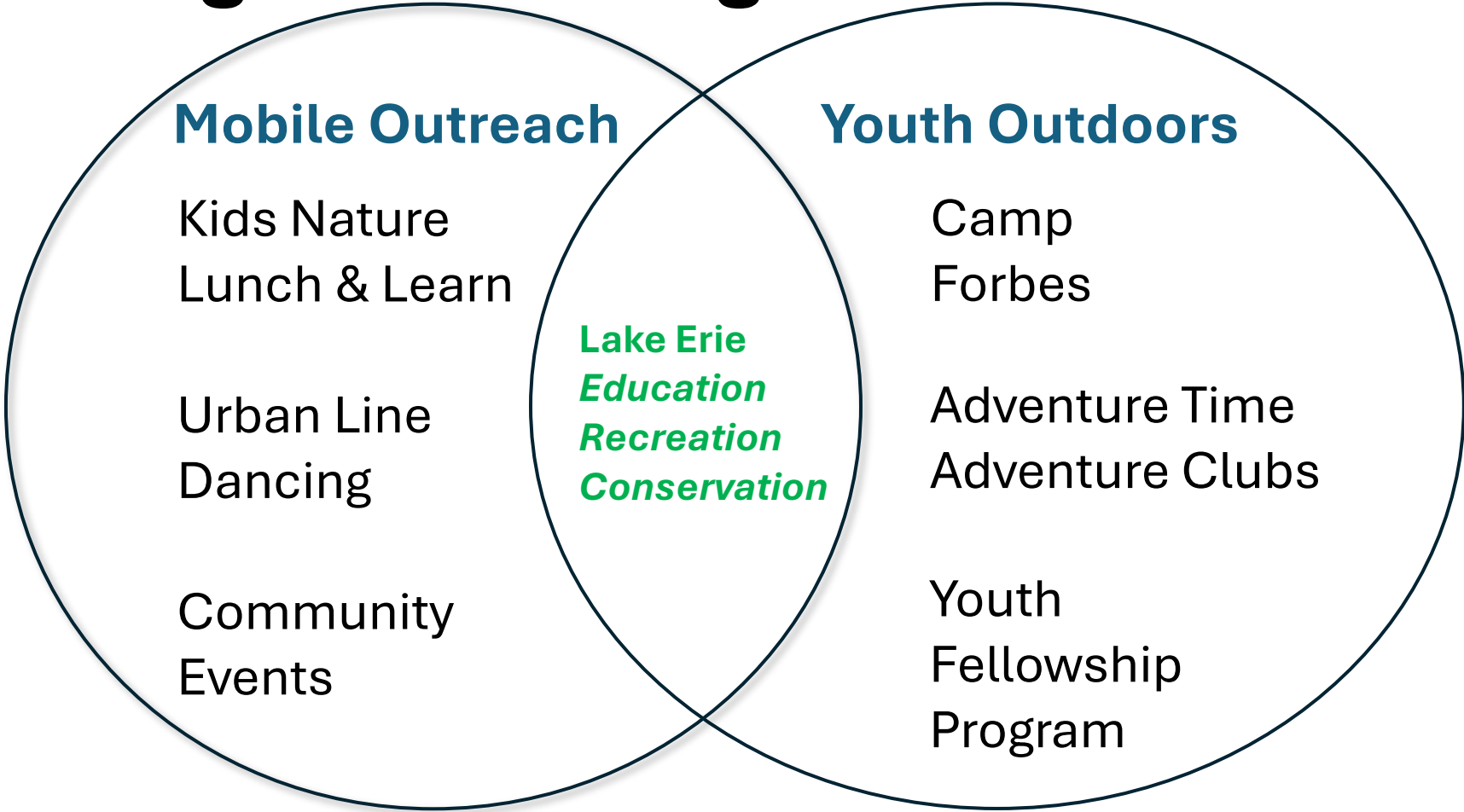

Euclid Beach STEM Adventure Camp – The Journey

- Euclid Beach Camp started in 2022
 - 4 weeks of camp
 - 65 campers
 - GCFB, CPL, hopes and dreams
- 5 years later
 - 7 weeks of camp
 - 160+ campers capacity
 - Teen days, winter camps, Wild Wednesdays, Skunks & S'mores, family days, special invites to events
- IMLS (Institute of Museum and Library Sciences)
 - 2023 – denied
 - 2024 – awarded
 - 2025 – defunded
 - 2025.2 - FUNDED

Funding My Great Lake

- IMLS Federal Grant
 - \$237,000
 - Program supplies, 1 FT staff, 2 seasonal staff
 - 3 years
- Donations
 - \$330,000 My Great Lake
 - \$100,000 Youth Outdoors Fellowship Program
 - 120 sunfish from Jones Lake Management
- \$667,000 in external funding in 2026
