This provides a great way to sell some of your equipment, while giving others the chance to pick up the equipment needed to try out a new adventure or find a new piece of gear. Backpacking, camping, cycling, canoeing, fly fishing, kayaking, mountain biking, stand up paddleboarding equipment and related gear is the focus of the used gear swap, so gather up your gear and come to Adventure University!

Used Gear Rules and Procedures – for those selling a bunch of items and want their own table

- **Call 216-341-1704 to reserve your table.**
 - Selling costs \$10 for your first table/space with each additional table or large item costing \$5
 - You can pay when you reserve your table over the phone or on-site during check-in on Saturday
 - You manage all your sales and transactions much like at a yard sale

Consignment Rules and Procedures – for those wanting to drop off and sell 5 items or less

- **Fill out the form below and email to Zach Tolles at zct@clevelandmetroparks.com**
- Drop off your items in the Consignment Area managed by Baldwin Wallace Outdoor Adventure Club
- They will provide you with tags to mark and price your items.
- They manage the sale and payment – only selling the item for what price you put on it.
- From 3:00-4:00 come on back to gather your cash or unsold items, consignment fee is 10%, max of \$50.

Prohibited items include, but not limited to the following:

- Firearms, large knives, used climbing gear, traditional sport gear, and motorized equipment
