

## **Archery Range Rules**



ATTENTION: Archery is a potentially dangerous activity. Archery equipment can be dangerous and, therefore, must be handled properly and safely at all times. Please report all unsafe conditions to Cleveland Metroparks Rangers by calling 440-333-4911.

THE ARCHERY RANGE IS OPEN DAILY FROM DAWN UNTIL DUSK, APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 31

## Always follow these range rules:

- 1. All archers must sign in at the kiosk before shooting.
- 2. All participants under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 3. No pets allowed on the range.
- 4. Alcohol is prohibited.
- 5. Crossbows, Broad Head Tipped Arrows, and Firearms are prohibited. Only field tips may be used.
- 6. All archers must shoot from a common shooting line Walk up shooting is prohibited.
- 7. Before shooting, archers must inspect equipment to ensure they are in proper working condition.
- 8. Never shoot an arrow into the air or "sky-draw".
- 9. Do not load arrows unless the range is clear and all shooters are on the common line.
- 10. Only retrieve arrows when all bows have been made safe and all shooters agree to retrieve arrows.
- 11. No more than six arrows may be shot between retrievals.
- 12. Only shoot at the designated targets. Hunting is prohibited.
