Required supporting materials:

- **Photographs** - Send at least three individual high resolution/publishable image files (4x6in and 300dpi, <1MB) attached separately from the report that describe your project. Please include appropriate captions for each. Each caption should correspond to a numbered image and include basic information about the activity, animal, habitat, person in the photo and the significance of the picture to the project. Please include the name of the photographer (for photo credit). ***Please only send photos cleared for use/publication.**
