









WAYFINDING FROM AREA HIGHWAYS

- Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) administers the Supplemental Guide Signage program
- Program requires annual attendance of 200,000
- Cleveland Metroparks requested additional signs last November
- ODOT approved a portion of the request and provided the signs
