Longnose Gar

Lepisosteus osseus



ADULT SIZE

Typically 24-40 inches and 1-7 pounds. Can reach lengths of 54 inches in Ohio.

TYPICAL FOODS

Primarily they feed on small fish and occasionally crayfish.

FISHING TIP

Very difficult to hook when they bite due to their hard, narrow "beak" full of needle like teeth. In some areas gar are targeted by slowing reeling in a short 3-4 inch piece of frayed white nylon rope as a "lure" with no hooks. Their teeth get tangled in the rope similar to Velcro. They are occasionally caught by accident when anglers target other species with bait & lures.
