## SAFETY RULES & REGULATIONS

### All Watercraft

- You must be 18 years of age to rent a watercraft at Hinckley Lake Boathouse.
- Your driver's license will be held until your watercraft is returned and confirmed clean and in good condition and all supplies/equipment returned.
- A waiver must be filled out. It must include the name and signature of everyone riding on your watercraft (adults must sign for children under 18 years of age).
- The rental charges are paid before watercraft is used.
- No switching or sharing of watercraft allowed.
- Swimming is prohibited on upper Hinckley Lake. Swimming is permitted at the Spillway Swim Area.
- Hinckley Lake Boathouse staff will provide and adjust a PFD (Personal Floatation Device) for each person that will be on a Cleveland Metroparks watercraft. The PFD must remain with you at all times. If you bring your own PFD, staff will confirm that it is U.S. Coast Guard approved and fits properly.
- All minors (under the age of 18 years old) must wear a PFD at all times while on Cleveland Metroparks watercraft.
- Staff will also provide instructions, paddle/oars, and assist you with getting into the appropriate watercraft.
- Payment for any damages, lost items or late fees will be made upon the return of the watercraft.
- Every boater is responsible for the care and proper handling of all Cleveland Metroparks property. You are responsible for any damage or injury caused to you or other boaters by your actions.
- Boats must be returned to the same place as they were taken.
- There is no smoking or cooking on any Cleveland Metroparks watercraft.
- Dogs are permitted on rowboats only. You must clean up after your dog as necessary.
- **If you have an Emergency: call 911 -or- Ranger dispatch at 440-333-4911**
- If you need non-emergency assistance, please call the boating assistance phone number (see boating assistance sticker found on all boats).
- **When the Emergency siren sounds: return to the Boathouse immediately.**
- **If there is lightning: immediately go to the nearest shore and get off the watercraft.**

### Boats with Motors

- A refundable deposit is required on boats with motors. If damage is done to the boat or motor and it exceeds the deposit amount, additional charges may be added.
- Boats with motors are prohibited from going into designated shallow areas.

### Pontoon Boat

- You must be 18 years of age to pilot the pontoon boat.
- The pilot must wear the kill-switch lanyard while the boat is motoring.
- Guests must be seated inside the gate while the boat is motoring.
- Cooking, smoking, animals and swimming off of the pontoon boat are prohibited.
