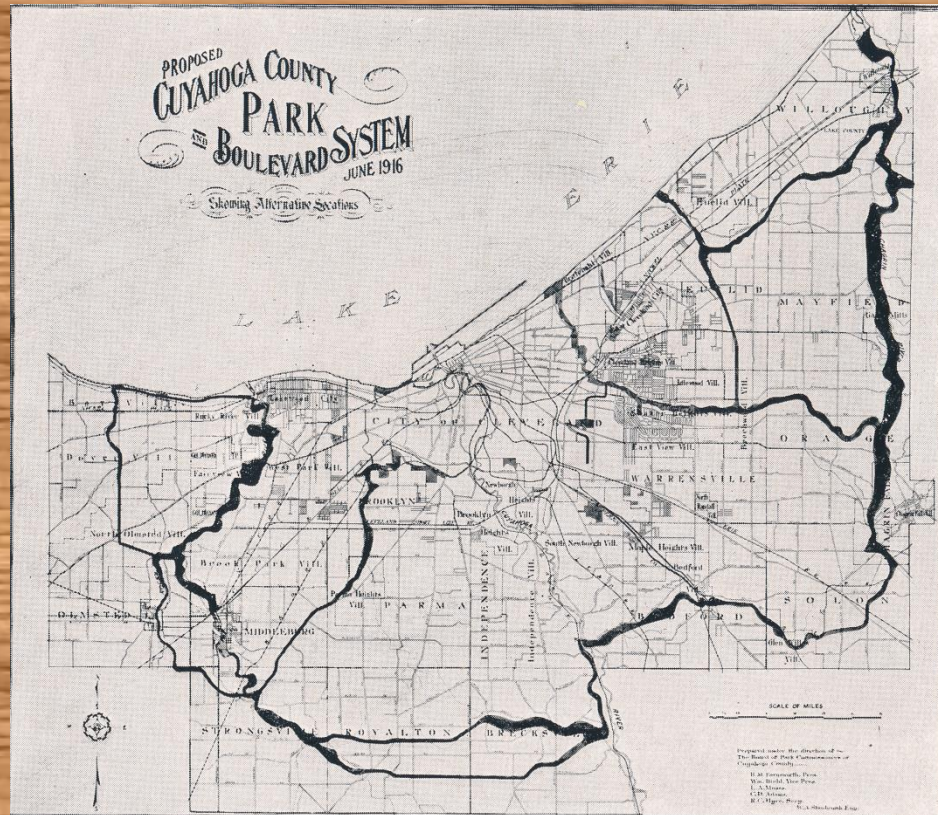

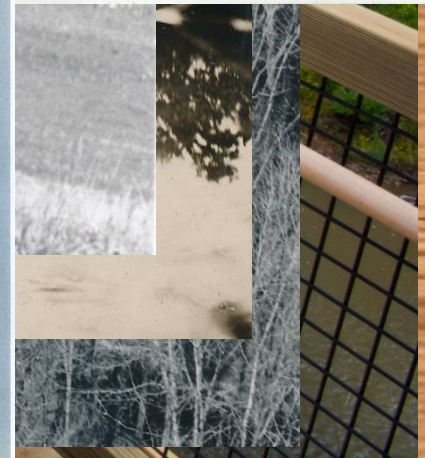

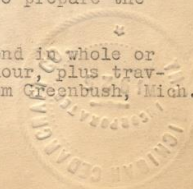
All Cedar work to be made and stained Umber creosote at Greenbush, Mich.

screws or bolts. We will not furnish the Cement work nor any of the Mill
work Lumber for the flooring, roof sheeting, or the roofing paper.

We would like two weeks notice at Greenbush to prepare the
Cedar for shipment.

We will furnish a man if desired to superintend in whole or
part, erection of our material at a cost of \$1.25 per hour, plus trav-
elling and hotel expenses. (Railroad fare and berth from Greenbush, Mich.
to Detroit is about \$11.00 per trip).

Henry Church.

A Sketch of the Most Interesting Character in Chagrin Falls—A Blacksmith, Painter and Sculptor.

Henry Church is the name of the most interesting and best known character in Chagrin Falls. He is a blacksmith, not the blacksmith who tried to mend a watch but the blacksmith who paints pictures and paints them well. Besides that he is somewhat of a sculptor. Tall and slightly stoop shouldered, with a kindly eye, he at once suggests something, you know not what. One would take him as a genius at first sight, and they would not be greatly mistaken, for a genius he certainly is.

In 1833 the parents of Henry Church set

grew rapidly and when but twelve years of age was large, strong and hearty and able to wield an ax in the rapidly growing clearing.

Each chip that fell at the stroke of his ax seemed to take shape under his hand. A hand of an artist fashioned it and the artist within him was slowly asserting himself. The logs in the gate, the log horn watering trough and all the crude implements about the house were fashioned with care and attention. It was plain that he was not meant for a humble station in life and he worked on. Of the true technique and color he knew nothing, there were no tools at his command and if

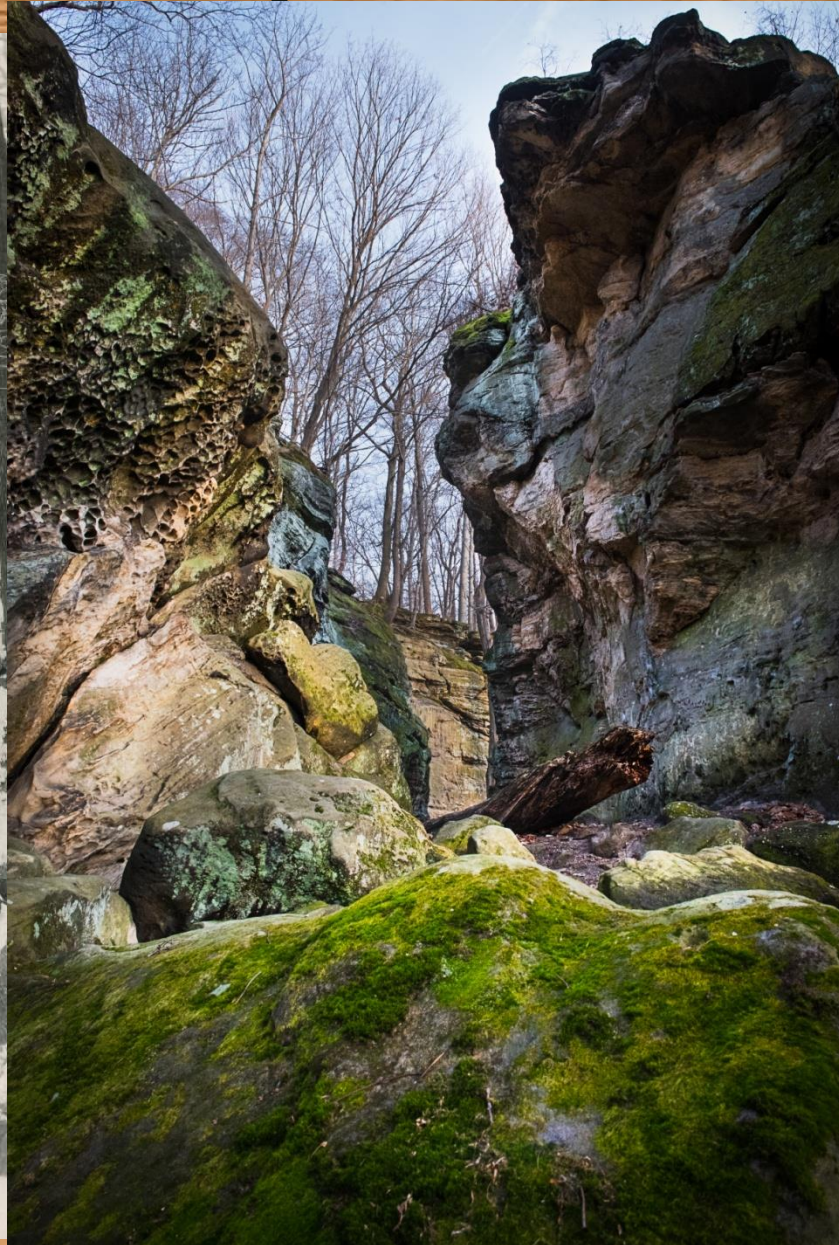
