



Cleveland Harbor Eastern Embayment Resilience Strategy

- In-water design fully funded; currently at 60% milestone and being coordinate with USACE on a bi-weekly basis
- Potentially USACE's preferred alternative for the 20-year Cleveland Harbor Dredge Material Management Plan (DMMP) and possible cost-sharing agreement
- **Habitat Loop Early Action Project design is shovel-ready**
- Monthly meetings with 6 main partners + key stakeholders
- Quarterly stakeholder meetings incl. 50 organizations


