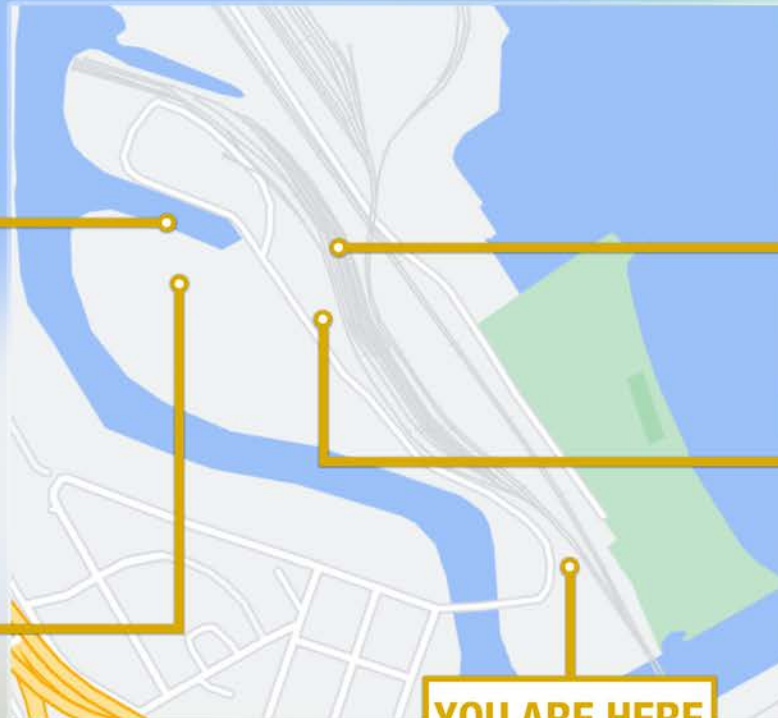


Cargill's Cleveland Salt Mine
