- + Grant submittal due Friday, August 18








#### **Scale Comparisions + Precent Active Recreation**




#### **Program Types**






#### **Program Distribution**



#### **Program Distribution -Option #3**








#### **USACE Coordination and Benefit-Cost Assessments**

GOAL: USACE 20-Year DMMP Identifies CHEERS as Recommended Plan for the Federal Navigation Project as a Local Led (Non-Federal) project through a cost-sharing agreement (possibly a 217).
