Background

Cleveland Metroparks has cultivated trademark rights to the mark ASIAN LANTERN FESTIVAL[™], reaching throughout Ohio and Western Pennsylvania to attract visitors to the Cleveland Metroparks Zoo's annual summer light show since 2018. Without authorization, the Pittsburgh Zoo is using the mark ASIAN LANTERN FESTIVAL to promote its own inaugural light show scheduled to begin later this summer. The Pittsburgh Zoo's unauthorized use is likely to confuse and mislead consumers.
