Lakefront Reservation:

Lakefront Reservation encompasses Edgewater Park, Wendy Park, East 55th Street Marina, East 72nd fishing area and North Gordon Park Boat Ramp. Stretching along Cleveland's north coast, Lakefront Reservation connects guests with the region's most valuable natural resource, Lake Erie. Lakefront Reservation has become a regional destination. Beaches, trails, marinas, boat docks, all purpose trails and large green spaces offer guests a variety of experiences along the shore. There are abundant opportunities for recreation and relaxation as well as special events. Guests can enjoy views of the Cleveland skyline, Cuyahoga River and lakefront along the Cleveland Lakefront Bikeway, Whiskey Island Trail, and Wendy Park Bridge and make connections to the Cleveland Foundation Centennial Lake Link Trail and Connectors, Red Line Greenway and Towpath Trail.

Park Rules:

A complete set of Cleveland Metroparks rules and regulations which carry criminal consequences can be found at clevelandmetroparks.com

- Respect the fragile nature of the environment by staying on the trails.
- Enjoy the natural environment, but do not disturb, destroy, deface, injure or remove any part of the Park District including plants, animals, rocks, buildings, signs, equipment or property.
- Put litter in trash containers even if it's not your own.
- Cats and dogs must be on a leash not more than 8-feet long and are the only pets permitted in the Park District. Clean up after your pet.
- Class 1 and 2 e-bikes and scooters are permitted on roadways and all purpose trails.
- Reservation hours 6 a.m. 11 p.m.
- Fishing is permitted with an Ohio fishing license, except in posted areas.
- The use of drugs is not permitted.
- Alcohol use is only permitted in designated areas.

Trail Etiquette:


- Control your speed and maintain a safe distance.
