2022 Visitation Overview

Three types of visitation are measured for Cleveland Metroparks.

(1) <u>Visitor Occasions</u> - The number of people *entering* Cleveland Metroparks reservations by vehicle, foot, or bicycle for any reason. This includes all of those who travel through the parks as well as those who visit the parks for recreational purposes.

(2) <u>Recreation Visits</u> - Only includes those who *park their vehicles or arrive by foot/bicycle/in-line skate, etc.* to use the parks.

(3) <u>Commuter/Scenic Driving Visits</u> represents the number of vehicles and visitors unaccounted for by Recreation Visits. It is estimated by taking the difference between Visitor Occasions and Recreation Visits.

 - In order to increase the overall accuracy of the annual visitation estimate, a selection of reservations have been reviewed in-depth each year (including persons per car multipliers and parking lot weights).

Research Assistants: Data Collection & Visual Observations

- Responsible for maintaining and collecting data from over 150 traffic meters
 - Nearly 100 collected monthly, the remainder quarterly
- Conducting ongoing visual observations at each reservation
 - Observing number of cars entering as well as number of people per car
- Documenting closures, inclement weather, and anything that may impact attendance counts
